



# Marine Forecasts glossary

## Cloud & Sunlight Terms

---

|                        |   |
|------------------------|---|
| <b>Sunny</b>           | Clear skies and unbroken sunshine.                    |
| <b>Sunny intervals</b> | Sun appears between periods of cloud.                 |
| <b>Bright</b>          | Good light levels; may include sun behind thin cloud. |
| <b>Clear</b>           | No clouds (used mostly for nighttime).                |
| <b>Fine</b>            | Dry, with sunshine or some brightness.                |
| <b>Fair</b>            | Dry, but with more cloud than a "fine" day.           |
| <b>Partly cloudy</b>   | Mix of cloud and clear skies.                         |
| <b>Cloudy</b>          | Mostly cloud-covered.                                 |
| <b>Overcast</b>        | Complete cloud cover. Dull, grey skies.               |

## Rain & Precipitation

---

|                        |   |
|------------------------|---|
| <b>Light rain</b>      | Drizzle or short, gentle showers.                                 |
| <b>Showers</b>         | Intermittent, often sudden bursts of rain. Can be heavy or light. |
| <b>Heavy showers</b>   | Short but intense rainfall.                                       |
| <b>Rain</b>            | Steady precipitation over a longer period.                        |
| <b>Heavy rain</b>      | Persistent and intense rainfall.                                  |
| <b>Drizzle</b>         | Very light rain, fine droplets.                                   |
| <b>Patchy rain</b>     | Rain falling in some areas but not others.                        |
| <b>Thunder showers</b> | Showers accompanied by thunder.                                   |
| <b>Sleet</b>           | Mix of rain and snow.   |
| <b>Snow</b>            | Falling snowflakes; may settle depending on temperature.          |
| <b>Hail</b>            | Ice pellets falling during cold showers or storms.                |

## Gale warnings

---

|                        |   |
|------------------------|---|
| <b>Gale</b>            | Winds of at least Bft force 8 (34-40 knt) or gusts reaching 43-51 knt |
| <b>Severe gale</b>     | Winds of force 9 (41-47 or gusts reaching 52-60                       |
| <b>Storm</b>           | Winds of force 10 (48-55) or gusts reaching 61-68                     |
| <b>Violent storm</b>   | Winds of force 11 (56-63) or gusts of 69 or more                      |
| <b>Hurricane force</b> | Winds of 12 (64 or more)  |

## Time

---

|                 |  |
|-----------------|--|
| <b>Imminent</b> | Expected within 6 hours of time of issue       |
| <b>Soon</b>     | Expected within 6 to 12 hours of time of issue |
| <b>Later</b>    | Expected more than 12 hours from time of issue |

## Visibility & Air Quality

---

|                        |  |
|------------------------|--|
| <b>Mist</b>            | Light, thin fog with visibility usually > 1 km.  |
| <b>Fog</b>             | Dense cloud near ground, visibility < 1 km.      |
| <b>Dense fog</b>       | Very low visibility. Hazardous.                  |
| <b>Hazy</b>            | Reduced clarity, often due to pollution or dust. |
| <b>Dust/sand storm</b> | Rare in UK but possible in special conditions.   |

## Sea State Terms (Wave Height-Based)

---

|                       |            |  |
|-----------------------|------------|--|
| <b>Calm (glassy)</b>  | 0          | Sea like a mirror. No waves.                 |
| <b>Calm (rippled)</b> | 0 – 0.1    | Smooth surface with slight ripples.          |
| <b>Smooth</b>         | 0.1 – 0.5  | Small wavelets, no foam crests.              |
| <b>Slight</b>         | 0.5 – 1.25 | Short but clearly defined waves.             |
| <b>Moderate</b>       | 1.25 – 2.5 | Small waves becoming longer; some whitecaps. |
| <b>Rough</b>          | 2.5 – 4.0  | Large waves, many whitecaps.                 |
| <b>Very rough</b>     | 4.0 – 6.0  | Large waves with foam and spray.             |
| <b>High</b>           | 6.0 – 9.0  | Powerful waves, foam blown in streaks.       |
| <b>Very high</b>      | 9.0 – 14.0 | Towering waves, great impact.                |
| <b>Phenomenal</b>     | over 14.0  | Exceptionally high waves, extremely rare.    |
